



2017/2018 RATES FOR CHUMBE ISLAND

(6th June 2017 – 8th April 2018)

Chumbe Island Coral Park is private, not for profit Marine Protected Area that offers guests a chance to protect and explore the coral reef and coral rag forest on the island. Guests relax in one of our 7 state of the art, exclusive eco-bungalows designed to have zero impact on the environment. Our award winning and internationally recognized conservation and education initiatives are directly supported and made possible by our guest's tariffs.

HIGH SEASON
(5 th June - 30 th Sept 2017 and 16 th Dec 2017 - 28 th Feb 2018)
US\$280 per person per night (sharing)
Single supplement: US\$ 100 which is not commissionable to agents
LOW SEASON
(1 st Oct 2017 - 15 th Dec 2017 and 1st March 2018- 8th April 2018)
US\$260 per person per night (sharing)
Single supplement: US\$ 80 which is not commissionable to agents
DAY TRIP
\$90 per person, in open bungalow shared by day trippers (can be booked 2 days in advance, subject to availability)

Note:

- Children aged 12 and under get 50% discount & 2 years and below are free of charge
- Minimum stay during 24th Dec-2nd January is 3 nights

The rate is per person per night inclusive of:

- Boat transport to and from the island on the morning transfers. The boat to Chumbe leaves from Mbweni Ruins Hotel; Check in time is 09:30 am for a 10:00 am boat departure. Check out is at 08:00 for 09:00 boat departure
- Accommodation in one of our 7 award winning Eco bungalows
- Full-board meals
- Boat transfers to the reef for snorkeling
- Snorkeling over one of the world's most pristine and diverse coral reefs (snorkeling equipment is provided)
- Guided tours through the coral rag forest
- Use of snorkeling equipment and tuition in snorkeling, if required
- Guided walks to view the endangered coconut crabs in the evening, the largest terrestrial crab on earth
- Sodas, water, coffee, tea and snacks
- laundry service and all taxes

To confirm your booking, 50% of the total amount should be paid, and the full balance must be paid at least 30 days before guest's departure to the island. No guest will be allowed to go to the island unpaid

Our cancellation policy:

Since Chumbe Island has only 7 eco-bungalows, their occupancy is very important to the success of our organization. Therefore, the following cancellation charges apply depending on the length of time before the reservation date:

- More than one week before the reservation date: 50% charge of the overall price
- 48 hours to one week before the reservation date: 75% charge of the overall price
- Less than 48 hours before the reservation date: 100% charge of the overall price
- Bookings starting on during 24th Dec-2nd January: 100% charge of the overall price

- In the unlikely event that Chumbe is unable to accommodate a confirmed booking or reservations, it may be necessary to offer an alternative of an equal or of other standard accommodation.
- If at any time Chumbe needs to make changes that will affect guest stay or we need to cancel your booking, we will inform you as soon as possible, offering a suitable alternative or a refund. This does not apply to small or minor changes during guest stay, resulting from circumstances beyond our control.
